I have composed music and produced numerous film/podcast scores and studio records. I have performed audio post-production (dialog editing/foley/sound design/mixing) for numerous film and podcast projects.

Video Editor, (1999 – Present):

I have edited across many genres, including narrative, sketch comedy, documentary, and corporate marketing/training videos. I have comprehensive expertise in the use of Adobe Creative Cloud, and am deeply familiar with establishing, optimizing, and executing post-production workflows.

I headed up production and post-production for all video of live events, which were live-streamed, and hosted on the organization's YouTube channel. I researched, designed, and executed live radio broadcasts from dozens of venues across California, each with unique challenges and limitations.

Lost Moon Radio is a musical sketch comedy ensemble based in Los Angeles. I have served as the live sound engineer/sound designer since 2010. I have produced 2 studio albums, a live album and ten 20-minute podcast episodes for the group including all engineering, mixing and mastering duties. I am responsible for producing and executing multiple-camera HD video shoots of each episode/special event. The group performs in a wide array of venues, each with unique production challenges for sound reinforcement, audio recording and video production, and rely on me to address these concerns, often in a limited timeframe.

Editor/Post-Production Coordinator, Wingspan Pictures (2010 – 2012)

I served as an editor and post-production coordinator at a busy L.A. production company specializing in educational content and marketing materials. Duties included editing, motion graphics, developing master workflows, and cataloging/backup systems for over 40 TB of active-use media.
